IGPI Fellowship Awards, January 2012

The Asian Federation of Early Career Psychiatrists has received a support from Indian Global Psychiatric Initiative (IGPI) 2012, taking place on 17th and 18th January 2012 in Amirtha Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi, Kerala, South India.

Programme for Early Career Psychiatrists is planned for Precongress period on 15th and 16th January 2012. Fellowship Awards for Early Career Psychiatrists (ECPs) will be given to 20 participants from India and 20 participants from the rest of Asia (including Egypt, Russia and Turkey as member societies in AFPA), 1 delegate from each country.

The Fellowship Award for Indian ECPs include*:

- the Registration Fee for the IGPI 2012,
- the precongress activity for Early Career Psychiatrists.

The Fellowship Award for the 20 delegates from member-societies of AFPA include:

- Registration Fee for the IGPI 2012,
- the precongress activity for Early Career Psychiatrists,
- shared accommodation for 4 nights.

The Fellowship Award for Asian ECPs from overseas and regions of Asia with no membership in AFPA include:

- the precongress activity for Early Career Psychiatrists.

*Travel grants are not included and recommended to be covered by national associations or participants themselves.

In order to receive the Fellowship Award, the participant should be:

1- An Early Career Psychiatrist (ECP), which means all psychiatric trainees and psychiatrists with less than 10 years of practice after finalizing the training, provided that they are less than 40 years old.

2- Nominated from an AFPA member society by recommendation letter from President of national association or, in case of non-membership in AFPA, from employer.
